

21st UCMAS INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION 2016

Introduction

UCMAS is a unique and scientifically-proven mental development program designed for children to develop their latent mental power at a very early age when brain development is reaching its peak.

21st UCMAS International Competition was held on 11th November'16 in Dubai, UAE. 3,000 students participated from various countries and all these participants were selected on the basis of merit in their respective countries. Participants were from Saudi, UAE, Bahrain, Qatar, Kuwait, Jordan, Lebanon, Malaysia, Singapore, Hongkong, Australia approx... From 24 countries.

Vanessa Thawani student of Dubai Gem School grade 3, 8 years old participant from Dubai won the International competition third position in Higher A group. Participants in this category had to perform 200 sums consisting of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division with each sum having eight rows and four digits in 8 minutes.

Vanessa has joined UCMAS from January 2015 and has been practicing since then. She participated in International Competition in 2015 and stood second runner up position in Elementary B Level. She also participated in National competition for UAE in May 2015 and stood second runner up in Junior level. She also cleared the Junior level exam conducted by parent body of UCMAS in Malaysia with distinction. She was encouraged by winning previous International and National competition and pursued for Higher A International competition 2016.
